

Want your commercial restaurant to possibly save water, energy, and time?

- New high efficiency PRSVs are reliable, better cleaning, time saving, water saving, and energy saving.
- The PRSV was found to be the highest water using fixture in commercial restaurants, compared to the dishwasher and bathrooms.
- Old PRSVs have rates of flow ranging from about 1.6 gpm to 5.0 gpm at 60 psi.
- New high efficiency PRSVs have rates of flow ranging from about 0.7 to 1.3 gpm at 60 psi.
- New high efficiency PRSVs are manufactured by Niagara, T&S Equipment, and Bricor.
- Prices range from about \$40 to \$80.

- Note: The Town of Breckenridge is not providing and not installing PRSV at this time.

Commercial Restaurants in Breckenridge are also encouraged to also look into retrofitting to the WaterSense labeled high efficiency 1.28 gallons per flush (gpf) toilets and the WaterSense labeled high efficiency 0.5 gpf urinals. More information can be found at www.epa.gov/watersense
