AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 8 OF TITLE 1 OF THE BRECKENRIDGE TOWN CODE CONCERNING THE USE OF A COLLECTION AGENCY TO COLLECT UNPAID FINES OR FEES IN THE MUNICIPAL COURT

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BRECKENRIDGE, COLORADO:

Section 1. Chapter 8 of Title 1 of the Breckenridge Town Code is amended by the addition of a new Section 1-8-15 which shall read as follows:

1-8-15: USE OF COLLECTION AGENCY: To collect on past due municipal court orders of fines or fees, the Town Manager is authorized to enter into one or more contracts with collection agencies. Any fees or costs of a collection agency shall be added to the amount due, but such fees and costs shall not exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the amount collected.

Section 2. Except as specifically amended hereby, the Breckenridge Town Code, and the various secondary codes adopted by reference therein, shall continue in full force and effect.

Section 4. The Town Council hereby finds, determines and declares that it has the power to adopt this ordinance pursuant to the authority granted to home rule municipalities by Article XX, Section 6 of the Colorado Constitution; and the powers contained in the Breckenridge Town Charter.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be published and become effective as provided by Section 5.9 of the Breckenridge Town Charter.

INTRODUCED, READ ON FIRST READING, APPROVED AND ORDERED PUBLISHED IN FULL this 14th day of March, 2017. A Public Hearing shall be held at the regular meeting of the Town Council of the Town of Breckenridge, Colorado on the 28th day of March, 2017, at 7:00 P.M., or as soon thereafter as possible in the Municipal Building of the Town.
