A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR AID IN HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCE INCIDENTS

WHEREAS, governmental entities are authorized by Article XIV of the Colorado Constitution and Part 2 of Article 1 of Title 29, C.R.S., to co-operate and contract with one another to provide any function, service, or facility lawfully authorized to each of the co-operating or contracting governmental entities; and

WHEREAS, a proposed "Intergovernmental Agreement For Aid In Hazardous Substance Incidents" between the Town and the Board of County Commissioners of Summit County, Colorado, the Office of Sheriff of Summit County, the Summit Fire Authority, and the towns of Blue River, Dillon, Frisco, and Silverthorne ("**IGA**") has been prepared, a copy of which is marked **Exhibit "A"**, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council has reviewed the proposed IGA, and finds and determines that it would be in the best interest of the Town to enter into the IGA.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BRECKENRIDGE, COLORADO, as follows:

Section 1. The "Intergovernmental Agreement For Aid In Hazardous Substance Incidents" between the Town and the Board of County Commissioners of Summit County, Colorado, the Office of Sheriff of Summit County, the Summit Fire Authority, and the towns of Blue River, Dillon, Frisco, and Silverthorne ("**Exhibit "A"**" hereto) is approved; and the Town Manager is authorized to execute such agreement for and on behalf of the Town of Breckenridge.

Section 2. This resolution is effective upon adoption.
