- 2. Based upon the foregoing, we make the following determinations of which persons have the greatest number of votes and were duly elected at the Regular Municipal Election of the Town of Breckenridge, Colorado held on Tuesday, April 7, 2020:
 - A. **Eric Mamula**, having received the highest number of votes for Mayor, is determined to be elected to fill the Mayoral vacancy for the Town of Breckenridge.
 - B. **Dick Carleton**, having received the highest number of votes for Town Council, is determined to be elected to fill the first of four vacancies on the Town Council.
 - C. **Jeffrey Bergeron**, with the second highest amount of votes for Town Council, is determined to be elected to fill the second vacancy on the Town Council.
 - D. **Kelly Owens**, with the third highest number of votes for Town Council, is determined to be elected to fill the third vacancy on the Town Council.
 - E. **Dennis Kuhn**, with the fourth highest number of votes for Town Council, is determined to be elected to fill the fourth vacancy on the Town Council. *This vacancy is a partial term of two years.*
- 3. The persons duly elected as set forth above are entitled to and shall be issued a certificate of election as provided by law.
